



## Identification of Radiation Equipment Designated Under the Radiation Protection Regulation

If you have purchased or acquired radiation equipment, you must arrange for it to be registered prior to use by contacting the Alberta Association for Safety Partnerships (AASP), the authorized Radiation Health Administrative Organization. The AASP has been designated to ensure that dental hygiene owners of radiation equipment are in compliance with the legislation. The AASP will issue a certification of registration for each piece of your radiation equipment.
